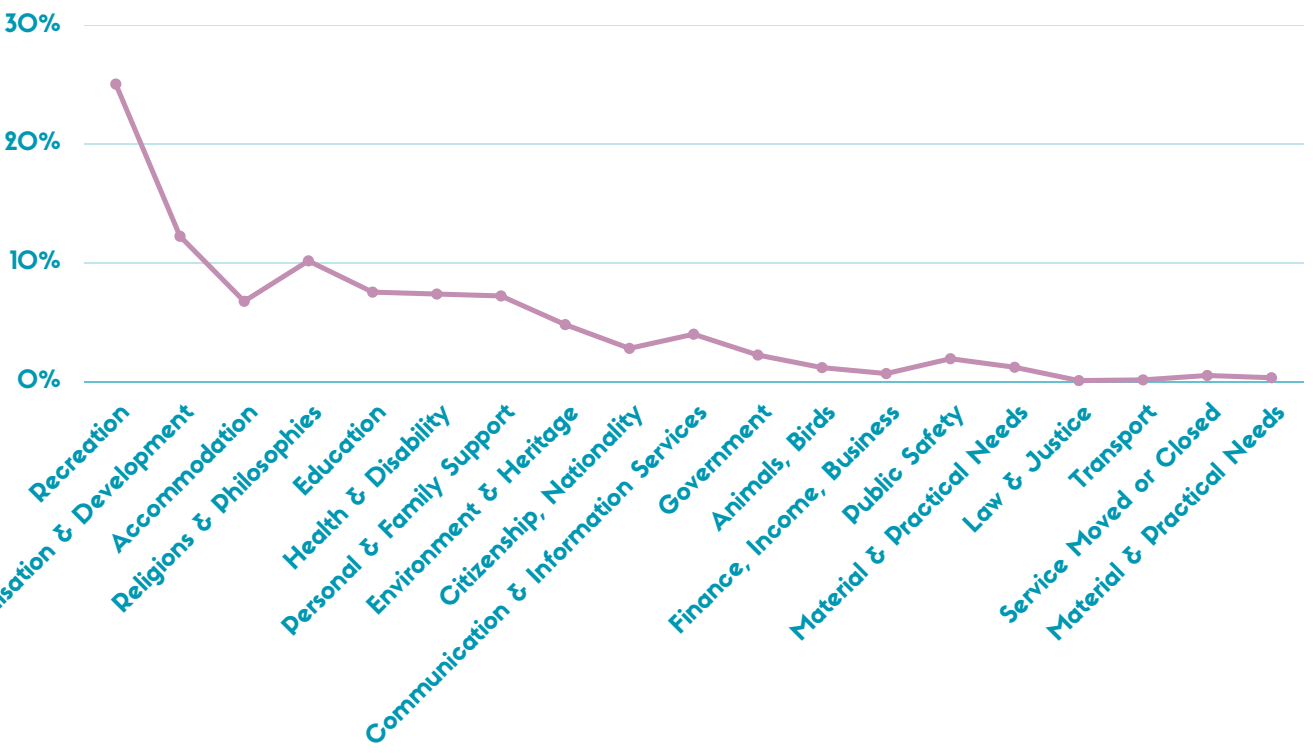
SERVICES USERS ARE MOST INTERESTED IN...
